ORDER:

1. Government of Andhra Pradesh has set up an IT Education Coordination Committee vide the reference first read above, to take steps for design and introduction of an innovative Postgraduate Programme in Information Technology.

2. In the first Meeting of the IT Education Coordination Committee (ITECC) held on 26.8.2000 it was decided that the expenditure on the preparatory activities related to the MSIT Programme will be incurred initially by APSCHE and shall be reimbursed to a tune of Rs. 25.00 lakhs immediately towards expenditure already incurred and for the immediate requirements. Accordingly an amount of Rs. 25.00 lakhs was sanctioned vide G.O. fifth above, to the APSCHE towards expenditure already incurred and for the immediate requirement for the next few months.

3. The ITECC in its Meeting held on 08.12.2000 decided that in addition to Rs.25.00 lakhs which is being released to APSCHE the balance amount of Rs. 125.00 Lakhs available for MSIT programme in the budget for IT&C for 2000-2001 should also be released to APSCHE. It is therefore proposed to release an amount of Rs. 125.00 lakhs to APSCHE as seed money for setting up the Centre for Distributed Learning (CDL), payments to consultants, faculty and staff appointed for the programme, organizing course development, mentors' training programmes and advances to participating institutions for creation of infrastructure as decided in the ITECC from time to time.

4. The ITECC also decided that the APSCHE would provide in turn, an advance to the following participating Universities / Institutions towards meeting a part of the outlay for setting up the initial infrastructure for MSIT Programme:

5. This advance from APSCHE to the Universities/Institutions for setting up infrastructural facilities will be adjusted against amounts payable by the CDL to the above institutions from the fee collected from the students, once the MSIT Programme is implemented.

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6. Government after careful consideration hereby release an amount of Rs. 125.00 lakhs and the amount will be debited to the following Head of Account:

The Joint Director and the DDO, IT&C Dept. will draw the above sanctioned amount by preferring a claim with the Deputy Pay and Accounts Officer, AP Secretariat, Hyderabad and remit the said amount through a Cheque favoring the A.P State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE). The A.P State Council of Higher Education will render audited Accounts for the amount released within six months from the date of release. The APSCHE shall furnish advance stamped receipt for Rs. 125.00 lakhs to this Department in triplicate.

8. This order issues in accordance with the Circular Memo of Fin& Plg. (Fin-BG) Dept. fourth read above.
