ORDER:

Government has decided to implement Secretariat Knowledge & Information Management System (SKIMS) Project in all the departments of Secretariat. Government entered into an agreement with Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) for System Study, Design, Development, Installation and Implementation of SKIMS. In the reference second read above, an amount of Rs.1.00 crore was sanctioned for software development and the amount on achieving the milestones prescribed in the agreement was subsequently released to M/s Tata Consultancy Services in installments.

2. The SKIMS architecture is based on Lotus products as approved by the Government as per the recommendations of the Project Implementation Committee constituted in the reference first read above. The requirement of Lotus products is assessed to be 2000 licenses of Business Collaboration Bundle (BCB) and 1,300 licenses of Communication Bundle. The PIC has decided to place order for procurement of full quantity i.e. 2000 licenses of Business Collaboration Bundle and 1300 licenses of Communication Bundle on the stipulation that 1000 BCB + 650 CB licenses will be taken initially and the delivery of the remaining will be staggered on the need basis with the following specifications:

1. Lotus Communication Bundle (CB):

- Domino Mail Server.
- Domino Application Server.
- Notes for Collaboration.
- Note for Messaging
- i-Notes
- Domino Designer.

2. Business Collaboration Bundle (BCB):

- Same time Server.
- Same time CAL
- Quick place.
- Mobile services for Domino Server/CAL

p.t.o.

- Easy sync.
- Domino Workflow Engine.
- Domino Workflow CAL.
- Enterprise solution builder standard edition.
- Domino.doc server.
- Domino.doc CAL.
- Domino Extended search CAL.
- Learning space collaboration module.

3. It is also decided as per the recommendations of the PIC that the entire amount shall be paid after the delivery of the first installment of 1000 BCB+650 CB licenses and that the date of warranty (free upgrades) of 1 year shall commence from the date of the actual delivery. The total cost was estimated at Rs.75,90,000/-.

4. Government after careful examination, hereby accord sanction and release an amount of Rs.75,90,000/- (Rupees seventy five lakhs and ninety thousands only) to APTS Ltd. towards the procurement of 1300 licenses of Lotus Communication Bundle and 2000 licenses of Business Collaboration Bundle of Lotus Products through TCS. APTS Ltd. will make necessary payments to TCS, Hyderabad as and when requested for by the Government.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:

3451 - Secretariat Economic Services
MH.102 – Secretariat – Schemes included in the Plan
SH(07) – Information Technology & Communications Department
190 - Machinery & Equipment
191 – Purchases.

6. The Joint Director, I.T & C. Department shall draw the amount sanctioned and released in para-4 above through an adjustment bill and credit the same to the P.D. Account No.4/336 of A.P.T.S. Ltd., Hyderabad under the credit Head of Account “8449-Other Deposits, MH.120-Miscellaneous Deposits of APTS Limited”. The Managing Director A.P.T.S. will submit an advanced stamped receipt for Rs.75,90,000/- (Rupees seventy five lakhs and ninety thousands only) in triplicate to this Department.

7. The TCS, Hyderabad shall place an order for total quantity of 2000 licenses of Business Collaboration Bundle and 1300 licenses of Communication Bundle of Lotus Products and initially procure 1000 licenses of Business Collaboration Bundle and 650 licenses of Lotus Communication Bundle for Government of Andhra Pradesh and install the same at Andhra Pradesh Secretariat. Other conditions are as decided by the PIC mentioned at para-2 & 3 above.

8. This order does not require the concurrence of Finance Department and the authorization from the Director of Treasuries as per the clarifications issued by Finance Department from time to time.
