IT&C Dept. - Online Transaction Processing (OLTP) System - Implementation in two Mandals on pilot basis – Constitution of Steering Committees – Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:

The Govt. of Andhra Pradesh has been implementing large statewide IT projects like Multi Purpose Household Survey (MPHS) and Computer-Aided Administration of Registration Department (CARD). The MPHS project is based on two huge databases viz., Citizen database and Land Records database. Government have also clearly identified the imperative need to keep these databases up-to-date. Integration of all major departments horizontally and vertically at Mandal / District / State levels derives the synergy arising out of inter-departmental sharing of data. Establishment of an Online Transaction Processing (OLTP) System is felt to be a long-term solution to this issue.

2. In the G.O. read above the Government laid down the objectives of the OLTP System pilot project and constituted the Project Implementation Committee (PIC), headed by the Director General, Dr. MCR HRD Institute of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad. The Committee evaluated various proposals through a 2-stage open tender process and recommended that 2 pilot projects be taken up based on two different technologies. Based on the recommendations of the PIC, Government decided to accord administrative approval and financial sanction for taking up 2 pilot projects of OLTP System subject to the following:

- a) Two OLTP System pilot projects will be taken up – one in the Bhongir Mandal of Nalgonda district and the other in Shadnagar Mandal of Mahaboobnagar district.
- b) Each pilot project shall be implemented at a cost of Rs.95.84 lakhs.
- c) The consortium of M/s. UTL and M/s. Inspira Technologies will take up the pilot project at Bhongir Mandal of Nalgonda district while the consortium of M/s. CMS and Ram Informatics Ltd., will take up the pilot project at Shadnagar Mandal of Mahaboobnagar district.
- d) The expenditure towards implementation of the above 2 pilot projects shall be met from the over all budget provision of IT&C department for the current financial year.

- e) The scope of the project broadly includes horizontal and vertical integration of 10 identified departments at the Mandal, district, and State levels besides connecting 10 villages in each of the Mandals by establishing Electronic kiosks and by providing hand-held devices also.
- f) The selected parties shall implement the project within a period of 4 months from the date of issue of LoI by APTS.
- g) APTS Ltd., the implementing agency, may enter into suitable agreement with the two consortia specifying the terms and conditions of the award, duly specifying the precise scope of the work, technical specifications, timeframe, terms of payment and any other relevant factors and entrust the project formally to the respective consortia.

3. With a view to ensure smooth and proper implementation of the pilot projects based on the different technologies at Bhongir and Shadnagar Mandals, Government hereby constitute the following Steering Committees at State, District and Mandal levels with the following composition:

4. The above Steering Committees may meet as often as required to ensure successful implementation of pilot projects at the Mandal level.

5. The expenditure of Rs.191.68 lakhs required to implement the 2 pilot projects sanctioned above, shall be debited to the following heads of account:
