ORDER:

Govt. of Andhra Pradesh keeping in view its experience in implementing eGovernance projects, especially the Online Transaction Processing (OLTP) pilot projects identified the need to have a Unifying Gateway Infrastructure as one of the most important infrastructure components required for eGovernance projects. The Project Implementation Committee of OLTP discussed and decided to appoint a consultant to advise and provide assistance during the entire lifecycle of OLTP relating to design and construction of such a gateway.

2. Dr. N. Janardhan, Chairman of M/s Haselfre Solutions Pvt. Ltd., who has vast experience in the field of eGovernance and undertaken similar work for Department of Company Affairs, Ministry of Finance, Government of India, was contacted in this regard and after detailed discussions, it was decided to avail his consultancy services for design, development and implementation of Unifying Gateway project, with the following scope:

- a. Provide a broad roadmap for integrating OLTP and certain critical databases for access across Departments and citizens through multiple end-user access equipment;
- b. Identify the key requirements in terms of the functional, non-functional and managerial requirements of Unifië-X infrastructure including the SLAs
- c. Design a suitable business model for implementation of the Unifië-X infrastructure
- d. Incorporate necessary eGovernance Standards into the specifications
- e. Draft the specifications for RFP including SLAs
- f. Advise on the bid process and provide necessary technical inputs for the bid process
- g. Handhold the successful bidder and manage the roll out of Unifië-X, interfacing MPHS-Citizen database and Land records database through different access providers
- h. Test out the solution construction by the successful bidder in independent lab so as to ensure compliance with SLA requirements

3. Payments for consultancy services are agreed upon as follows:

Government, after careful examination of the above, accord administrative sanction for establishing a Unifying Gateway project that would serve as critical infrastructure for implementing various eGovernment projects. It is also decided to engage the services of M/s Haselfre Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Chennai as a consultant to advise and provide assistance during the entire lifecycle of the above Unifying Gateway Project, subject to the terms and conditions stipulated in the agreement to be signed with the company, that has been approved by the Government.

5. M/s Haselfre Solutions Pvt. Ltd., shall commence work on the project immediately on signing the detailed agreement and by positioning the required number of consultants with adequate past experience in implementation of DCA-21 at Hyderabad. As several other key projects are dependent on this gateway, it is emphasized that the project shall be completed within the period stipulated in the agreement.

6. The entire expenditure of this project shall be met from out of the amount sanctioned to IIIT, Hyderabad vide G.O.Rt. No. 75 of IT&C

Department, dated 27-03-2003 for establishment of the Centre for Electronic Government at IIIT, Hyderabad.
