IT&C Department – Migrating from existing 16-digit code to 12-digit SSID format – Orders – Issued

1. G.O.Ms. No. 40, IT & C Department, dt. 14-08-2001.

ORDER :

Vide reference 1st read above, Government issued mandatory guidelines to be followed conforming to IT architecture and standards for implementation of major IT projects vide orders in the reference 1st read above.

2. Along with the guidelines, Meta data definitions were published for several common data elements that are likely to be used in various projects. These included Meta data definition for the Social Security Identification Number or SSID. A 12-digit format 9999-9999-9999 was adopted for SSID. It was also mentioned that as the existing SSID number was a 16-digit number, detailed guidelines regarding migration from the existing to the new SSID would be issued separately.

3. Recently, a very comprehensive effort has been made to update MPHS and prepare it for use by various departments. MPHS data has also been placed on the AP Online portal where it is accessible to departments, kiosks and citizens. OLTP pilot projects have also recently been launched in Bhongir mandal of Nalgonda district and Farooqnagar mandal of Mahaboobnagar district, that incorporate provision for reference and interoperability between software systems of each participating department and the MPHS database. Once OLTP is replicated, similar systems will become operational across the state. By placing the MPHS data on AP Online and providing SSID generation and related services through a central server, cross-references to the MPHS database can be implemented even before OLTP is replicated everywhere.

4. At this stage, when the government intends to use the MPHS data effectively through widespread linkage with various government projects to deliver citizen services, it is essential to switch over to the new 12-digit SSID format. Accordingly, after careful consideration, government hereby decide to migrate from the existing 16-digit number to the 12-digit SSID number for the entire MPHS database and to effect corresponding changes in all the eGovernment projects and applications that are linked to MPHS database.

5. It is further decided that AP Technology Services Limited shall take up a one time exercise for conversion from the existing 16-digit number to the

12-digit number for the MPHS database and communicate the same in sufficient copies to all Collectors for being used at Mandal Revenue Offices. After the initial generation of new SSID numbers for the existing MPHS records, AP Technology Services Ltd. shall also provide a facility for online submission of the requisite data by Mandal Revenue Officers and implementing generation of new SSID numbers.

6. As the MPHS database has already been placed on the AP Online citizen services portal, AP Technology Services Ltd. may work out the modalities for provision of online services pertaining to generation of SSID numbers as well as reference and cross-checking of existing SSID numbers.

7. This order does not require the concurrence of Finance Department.
