ORDER:

- In the reference second read above Government created the Department of Information Technology & Communications (IT&C). However the Department has been operating practically as a virtual Department so far with a few officers and one section only. The Department has identified thirty five areas in the IT and communications sector, on which work has to be done in an intensive manner, simultaneously, with un-diverted attention, if any progress or impact has to be made, as each item requires minute planning and going into details and follow-up action on a discordary basis to produce perceptible results. Further, most of the items also need services of officials and professionals who have the required aptitude, technical expertise and experience to enable correct and quick decision-making and implementation for speedy results to realize the vision of the Government.
- 2. Considering the circumstances, and keeping in view the responsibility entrusted to the IT&C Department, Government hereby accord sanction for the revised organization structure of the IT&C Department, duly organized into six wings shown below with details of functions and the structure of each wing (number of Posts) as shown in Annexure 1 of this Order:
 - 1) Policy Formulation and Planning Wing
 - 2) e-Governance Wing
 - 3) IT Promotion Wing
 - 4) Infrastructure Wing
 - 5) HRD Wing
 - 6) Administration Wing
- The above structure has been designed keeping in view the need to establish a thin organization, which is at the same time effective in driving the efforts of IT development in all splictes. In view of the financial position of the State, majority of the posts listed in Annexure I will be filled by suppressing/diverting an equal number of posts from other Secretariat Depts. / HODs, or organizations of the Government, so that the overall net additional outgo for the Government remains minimal. The remaining ten posts, which are to be filled from the open market, necessarily offering adequate compensation, commensurate with the expertise required, are separately listed in Annexure 2 of this order, along with qualifications prescribed. The said ten posts shall be filled on contract basis for a period of three years.

- 4. The orders issued in the reference third read above are hereby superseded the intent of the said orders are assentially covered in the functions and structure detailed in item B of Annexure-1 of this order. The revised organizational structure of the IT&C Department will now consist of 33 (thirty three) posts in all, including 16 (sixteen) new posts in all cadres.
- 5. Selection of personnel for the expanded organizational structure of the IT&C Department from other Sectt. Depts. / HODs / Government organizations, and also recruitment from open market for posts listed in Annexure 2, shall be entrusted to a Selection Committee headed by a Prl. Secretary to be constituted separately. The Committee will draw up requirements for each position, conduct interviews and recommend candidates with the required aptitude and expertise and the Government will thereafter make the appointments.
- 6. The total cost of the establishment of the IT&C Department will be met from within the allocation made for the Department in the Budget.
